Selki-Asema

Selki-Asema is a small company manufacturing and selling Finnish design. The company operates from the former railway station of the Village of Selki, situated 45 km north-west of Helsinki. Selki-Asema currently produces the work of five designers.

The history of Selki-Asema as a design company started in 2004. Jukka Merta who had previously worked as a metal workshop technician at the University of Art and Design Helsinki met two students, Mari Relander and Anna Katriina Tilli who were looking for a manufacturer for their Anemone lamp and tables. Merta started to produce the series and to actively search for other student prototypes with product potential. The Selki-Asema collection has since grown with the designs of Klaus Aalto; the CityBoy picnic grill and a series of modifiable coat racks called 5.1Mhz. Aalto also acts as Selki-Asema's art director and advisor. Other Selki-Asema designers are Elina Järvinen, Jari-Petri Voutilainen and Mikko Laakkonen. Järvinen has designed the TRe lamp series and J-P Voutilainen has designed the Plink light series. Laakkonen has designed the Vege grill pan which decorates the surface of the grilled meat with a floral motif. Vege received a mention at the Milano Furniture Fair in 2005.
